
# Setting up your phone Install a SIM/microSD card

## Step 1. Open the SIM/microSD card slot cover

With the phone facing down, open the card slot cover.




Step 2. Pull out the SIM/microSD card tray Hook your fingernail on the rib on the tray's top edge and pull it out.



NOTE: microSD cards are sold separately.

#### Step 3. Place a SIM and microSD card

Put the tray onto a flat surface and place a SIM and microSD card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down as shown.




Step 4. Insert the SIM/microSD card tray Insert the tray into the phone, being careful not to let the cards slide out. Then gently push the tray in until it clicks.



### Step 5. Close the SIM/microSD card slot cover

After the tray is all the way back in your phone, securely close the card slot cover.



NOTE: Make sure the SIM/microSD card slot cover is securely closed to maintain your phone's waterproof seal

WARNING: Do not use the phone under water with a broken or open SIM/microSD slot cover, USB/Charger port cover or headset lack cover.

When charging is complete, remove the cable from the port and securely close the cover.

WARNING: Use only approved chargers and cables with your phone. Improper handling of the charging port, as well as the use of an incompatible charger or cable, may cause damage to your device and void the warranty.

NOTE: Make sure the USB/Charger port cover is securely closed, when the port is not in use, to maintain your phone's waterproof seal.

#### Step 6. Charge your phone

Before turning on your phone, charge it fully.

Open the USB/Charger port cover and insert the small end of the USB cable into the phone. Insert the larger end into the charger and plug it into an outlet.



### Using your phone

#### Turning your phone on/off

To turn your phone on, press and hold the **Power** key.

Press and hold the **Power** key again to turn it off.

#### Locking/unlocking the screen

To turn on your screen, press the **Power** key. Then:

- Swipe up to open the Home screen.
- Swipe left to open the Camera app.
- Swipe right to launch Google Assistant.



To turn off your screen and prevent accidental key presses, press the **Power** key.

#### Make a Call

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 🔘 > DIALPAD.
- 2. Enter the phone number and tap to
